Chairman Jean Filostin traveled to Haiti in May to monitor and plan the following Projects:

May 2009

Institute of Grace joined World Harvest Ministries under the leadership of Sister Miriam. Medical team from the United States has travelled to the remote part of Haiti to hold mobile clinic in Pestel, Caimite Island, and Zetroi. Around 1,000 patients were treated. Critical cases were transferred to Hospital in Cayes.

Chairman Jean Filostin returned to Port-au-Prince the last week of May to do ground work at the Hospital Building in Merger to wait for Medical team scheduled to arrive in Haiti mid June.

Missionary team (18 people) from Bowie MD led by Rev. David Graves (Bowie Methodist Church) went to Merger, Haiti to work on construction of a fence of IOG hospital building.
