## Who Does the IOG serve?

IOG serves and supports in Port-au-Prince by running the Universite de la Grace in Delmas. In Merger the IOG has a primary school and is building Miracia Hospital, which opened as a clinic February 1, 2010. The IOG also provides ESL to French and Spanish speaking immigrants and math tutorial services to 100 children in Washington, D.C. The IOG continues to expand its vision to provide more services to more children as resources become available.

**Through its board, staff, and volunteers, the IOG concentrate its efforts on:**

**Education** – Providing quality educational opportunities in underserved areas.

**Health** – Providing medical and dental care by building a medical center in Merger.

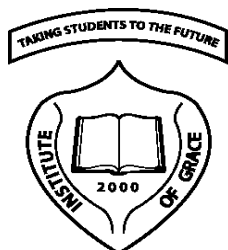
**Coordination** – Bringing together churches, non-profits, and businesses to combine their resources and expertise to implement healthcare services and educational opportunities in Haiti. HIV/AIDS, Community Development, Health, Business, and Leadership seminars are also sponsored throughout the year.

## How Can I Support the IOG?

**Financial** –contributions may be made by checks made out to “Institute of Grace” and are tax deductible. Elementary students may be individually sponsored for \$300 per school year. This covers all tuition, uniforms, and a lunch meal each day school is in session. Theology students may be sponsored for \$1,000 per school year. Business, Accounting, or Computer Science students may be sponsored for \$1,500 per school year. These courses run for four years.

**Materials** – Contributions of medical supplies, laptop computers, or other materials are welcome.

**Personal** – Some of the greatest contributions are made by those who travel to Haiti to volunteer their skills through medical/dental, construction, and education teams. Short and long-term mission options are available. Please contact us for more details.
